Travel Restrictions in Response to the 2019 Novel Coronavirus

Reference is made to my letter dated February 3, 2020 on the subject at caption.

Following Cabinet's decision to impose travel restrictions on the People's Republic of China due to the COVID-19 virus, you may be aware that, Cabinet by Minute No. 418 of February 27, 2020 has now agreed, inter alia, that:

"with immediate effect, travel restrictions be imposed on persons (except nationals of Trinidad and Tobago), living in or visiting South Korea, Italy, Iran, Japan or Singapore for a fourteen-day period following their departure from those countries".

The assistance of the Ministry of Foreign and CARICOM Affairs in communicating Cabinet's decision regarding travel restrictions to all relevant authorities, including Embassies, High Commissions and multilateral agencies is appreciated.
