

VEHICULAR TRAFFIC REPORTING CERTIFICATE

This certificate is issued for the operation specifically described herein. No person shall conduct any operation under the authorization of this certificate except in accordance with the Operations Specifications contained in this certificate and such other requirements of the Trinidad and Tobago Civil Aviation Regulations, 2004.

OPERATIONS AUTHORIZED

Observation and reporting of vehicular traffic conditions on highways and streets in Trinidad and Tobago.

OPERATIONS SPECIFICATIONS

- 1. A copy of completed application form TF-066 submitted for this certificate shall be attached to and become a part of this certificate.
- 2. Only the aircraft and pilot listed on the approved application form attached to this certificate shall be used in this operation subject to validity of the airworthiness certificate and the pilot in command having a valid commercial pilot licence and a minimum experience of 350 hours total flight time.
- 3. The pilot in command shall ensure that the flight causes as little annoyance or distraction as possible and that the aircraft is operated at all times within the requirements of the Regulations.
- 4. Operations are authorized for Day VFR conditions or prescribed minima specified by the Air Traffic Control.
- 5. The pilot in command shall adhere to basic rules of the air as required by the Trinidad and Tobago Civil Aviation Regulations [(No.2) Operations] Regulations, 2004, Part VII.
- 6. The pilot in command shall adhere to current NOTAMS, Temporary Flight Restrictions and have current knowledge of Prohibited/Restricted areas in the area of operations.
- 7. The pilot in command shall, during each flight continuously monitor radio communications with Air Traffic Control and advise Air Traffic Control on the termination of traffic reporting for that flight and the aircraft's return to the aerodrome.
- 8. Vehicular traffic reporting shall be aborted if, prior to the receipt of a required Air Traffic Control Authorization, or during any reporting period, the required radio communication system used for communication between the aircraft and Air Traffic Control becomes inoperative.
- 9. The certificate shall be presented for inspection upon request by an authorized representative of the Trinidad and Tobago Civil Aviation Authority.
- 10. The certificate holder shall be responsible for the strict observance of the terms and specifications contained herein.
- 11. This certificate is not transferable and, unless sooner surrendered, suspended or revoked, shall continue in effect until the expiry date.
