TTCAA statement on the Boeing 737-9 Max

The Trinidad and Tobago Civil Aviation Authority (TTCAA) wishes to advise all operators, stakeholders and persons of interest that the Boeing 737-9 Max, configured with a mid-cabin door plug installed, has been found by the Federal Aviation Administration not to be in a safe condition for use and has been prohibited from use in civil aviation operations. The TTCAA has also prohibited flights operations of the affected aircraft within and over Trinidad and Tobago effective 10 January 2024.

Currently there are no Boeing 737-9 Max aircraft registered in Trinidad and Tobago. Further, this aircraft type is not currently used by air operators for their service into Trinidad and Tobago.

The TTCAA will continue to actively monitor the developments with the Boeing 737-9 Max and provide updates as necessary.
