#### AIP Eastern Caribbean Amendment Service 2025/2026

##### Introduction

The AIM Publication Unit of the Trinidad and Tobago Civil Aviation Authority (TTCAA) is charged with the production of Aeronautical Information Products such as Aeronautical Information Publication (AIP), AIP Amendments, AIP Supplements (AIP SUP) and Aeronautical Information Circulars (AIC) for the following states: Anguilla, Antigua & Barbuda, British Virgin Islands, Dominica, Grenada, Montserrat, St. Christopher (St. Kitts)/Nevis, Saint Lucia, St. Vincent & the Grenadines and Trinidad & Tobago.

##### Updates

The AIM Publication Unit issues amendments to the ECAR AIP, a maximum of three times yearly, which are available exclusively on the TTCAA website (<https://caa.gov.tt/>) via passworded access.

The latest amendment and previous amendment are accessed via the AIP AMDT tab.

The AIP SUP and AIC tabs link users to the latest and valid AIP SUP and AIC publications and are available publicly to all users. The Trinidad and Tobago Charts tab links users to the latest updates to all charts for Trinidad and Tobago and are also publicly available to all users.

In order to accommodate on-time processing of amended data, AIP amendments are uploaded on the TTCAA website at least twenty-eight (28) days in advance of its effective date.

The complete and updated sections, subsections and printable AIP will only become available on the effective date, ensuring that current data is available at all times.

The Printable AIP makes printing of the complete sections possible as it contains updated and continuous sections of the AIP.

Valid NOTAM are available on the TTCAA website and are updated daily, while the monthly NOTAM Summary is transmitted via email to all subscribers within the first five (5) days of each month.

The following scheduled dates for AIP Amendments for 2025 and 2026 were determined in accordance with ICAO AIRAC effective dates published in Document 8126 - Aeronautical Information Services Manual, Part III, Chapter 3:

Data Originators are urged to work in harmony with the specified dates so that amendments, in particular AIRAC amendments, can reach users at least 28 days in advance of the effective date. Guidance on the use of the AIRAC System can be located in the AIS Manual Doc 8126, while Annex 15 – Aeronautical Information Services provides the Standards and Recommended Practices for its use.

Aeronautical data and aeronautical information submitted for publication must adhere to the publication requirement provided in Appendix 1 of the PANS AIM Doc.10066 ensuring that verification and validation activities are conducted prior to submission.

### Errors/Omissions/Observations

In compilation of the updated aeronautical publications, care will be taken to ensure that the information contained within it is accurate and complete. Any errors and omissions which may nevertheless be detected, as well as any correspondence concerning the Amendment Service should be communicated via the TCAA website using the AIM Contact page at <https://caa.gov.tt/aim-contact-us-page/>

On receipt of the acquisition request by the TCAA, purchasing subscribers will be provided with a proforma invoice.

**Current complimentary subscribers** wishing to continue receiving the ECAR AIP are also requested to complete and submit the online acquisition form annually so that records are kept current.
